

NSAA District D3 Cross Country Meet Spectators' Information

1. Race times and awards ceremony:
 - a. 4:00 p.m. Girls 5k Race
 - b. 4:45 p.m. Boys 5k Race
 - c. 5:30 p.m. Awards near picnic tables on farthest southeast building
2. Teams Competing: David City Aquinas Catholic, Centennial, David City, Deshler, Doniphan-Trumbull, Fillmore Central, Fullerton, Harvard (Girls Only), McCool Junction, Nebraska Christian, Palmer, St. Edward, Superior, Thayer Central, Tri County, Twin River, Wilber-Clatonia
3. **PARKING**
 - a. **All fans should enter Camp Kateri through the Bus and Fan Parking Entrance/Exit. There will be parking attendants to direct you from there. What you need to tell them at that point is if you will be staying for the entire meet, or leaving before the races are over. Based on that decision, they will direct your parking from there.**
 - b. **Please notice on the maps that the Bus and Fan Parking Entrance/Exit is also a part of the course. This entrance leads to Fan Parking Lot 1 and Team Parking/Fan Parking Lot 2. People who park in this area will need to arrive before the girls race by 3:50. Nobody will be allowed in and out of those parking lots from 3:50 until the conclusion of the races.**
 - c. **If you arrive before 3:50, and know you have to leave early, you can enter through the Bus and Fan Parking Entrance/Exit and park in Fan Parking Lot 3. The exit for this parking lot does not interfere with the course. This parking lot will be a first come, first serve basis. Once it is full nobody will be allowed into this lot.**
 - d. **If you plan on arriving late or leaving early and Fan Parking Lot 3 is full then you will have to park on the gravel road to the north of Camp Kateri. This is the road you will be driving on to enter the camp.**
4. We have given you maps of each race. Any part of the course is fair game for viewing. Please just stay clear of meet workers and runners competing. If a trail is flagged off, that trail is flagged off so runners do not take a wrong trail. However, spectators can feel free to navigate those trails to watch each race.
5. This year the map includes course markings every 400 meters and also every 1000 meters so viewers can have an idea of where runners are at in a race. All of these locations identified on the map also have a t-post with a banner, indicating those distances on the course itself.
6. Please note where the bathrooms are located on your map. There is a unisex bathroom on the east side of the bathroom building and male and female bathrooms with multiple stalls on the west side of the bathroom building.
7. At the conclusion of the meet we will have an awards ceremony near the patio of the southeast most building. This awards area is shown on the map with an arrow pointing to that area. Here we will hand out 15 individual medals for the girls and boys 5000 meter races. Championship and runner-up plaques will also be awarded to the top two teams in the girls and boys varsity races.
